## Spondon Priorities

On Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2011 Spondon Neighbourhood forum was held and the following priorities were agreed collectively by the Police, Council and members of the community;

### 1) Auto crime and Dwelling Burglaries

#### **Burglary dwellings reported to police**

01/08/11- 31/08/2011 – We had 2 Dwelling Burglary reported to police. Offenders have forced entry and stolen various items of Jewellery, tools and electrical equipment taken and in the second jewellery and electrical equipment taken.

01/07/11- 31/07/11- We have had 4 dwelling burglaries reported to the police. Two were attempts with no entry gained and the other two were forced entry. One had money and jewellery and taken and the other had a car taken with keys from the house.

01/06/11- 30/06/11- We have had 3 dwelling burglaries reported to the police. Two of these were sneak-in burglaries, one of which had a vehicle stolen.

#### **Auto crime reported to the police**

01/08/11-31/08/11 – We have had 12 Theft from Motor vehicle offences reported to police and 2 Theft of Motor vehicle.

01/07/11- 31/07/11- We have had 3 auto crime offences reported to police. Of these, two were theft from motor vehicles and one was a theft of motor vehicle.

01/06/11- 30/06/11- We have received 2 calls for service. These were both theft from motor vehicle offences.

The amount of vehicle crime over the past three months has remained relatively steady, although did increase slightly in August. There has been 4 arrests in relation to the Theft from Motors vehicles and enquiries are ongoing. Operation Chirdon is continuing, which has included high visibility deterrent patrols in the auto crime hotspots as well as covert patrols to catch unsuspecting burglars. The amount of burglaries over the last three months has been low, remaining at between one and four, offenders have been arrested and interviewed with regards to one of the burglaries and enquiries are ongoing. We also have a suspect outstanding for another with enquires still ongoing.



## 2) Antisocial Behaviour on Park Road

Incidents reported to police plus 200metres

01/08/2011 – 31/08/2011 – According to incidents Police have received no calls for service to the area.

01/07/11-31/07/11 We have had 5 incidents of ASB reported to the police. Three of these incidents involved groups of youths walking along, drinking and swearing, there was one incident involving a youth on a motorbike and one involving youths throwing stones.

01/06/11 - 30/06/11. We have had 2 calls for service for ASB; these have included youths drinking in the street, and possible drug usage.

Over the last few months we have seen a general drop in calls for service for Park Road. We have been conducting focussed patrols in this area, and positively dealing with incidents of antisocial behaviour, completing ASB referrals where appropriate. Also with the continuance of Operation Selset, we have utilised further police resources to target areas of ASB, including Park Road, which may have also reduced calls for service.

## 3) Anti Social Behaviour on Brunswood Park

Incidents reported to police plus 200 meters surrounding area

01/08/11 – 31/08/11 Looking at incidents police have received 1 call for service to Brunswood Park. We did however receive 3 reports of youths fighting at the precinct on the 19/08/11.

01/07/11 – 31/07/11 We have had three calls for service. One of these has been youths drinking on the park and the other two were groups of youths congregating on the precinct.

01/06/11- 30/06/11 We have had 2 calls for service. These have been groups of youths drinking on the park.

Throughout August we have continued to use the same intervention strategies in this ASB hotspot, which appears to have produced a reduction in calls for service in this area.



### Anti-Social Behaviour in General:-

During August the Spondon Safer Neighbourhood team made 6 referrals to the Anti Social Behaviour Team, in the last three months a total of 28 referrals were made.

### Crime and detection Figures:-

Between 1<sup>st</sup> August and 31<sup>st</sup> August, Spondon crime figures are as follows;-

The figures show a total of 76 crimes in Spondon area in August 2011 which is an increase of 31.0% on same period last year. Burglary Dwelling has been reduced from 5 to 2 compared to this time last year which is a reduction of 60.0%.

Over August Spondon has seen 32 of the crimes dealt with by way of positive outcome which equates to 42.1%. Last year the detection figures were at 58.6%.

### Events/Operations:-

Operation Chirdon is continuing in Spondon to tackle auto crime in the local area with high visibility deterrent patrols and covert patrols to detect and arrest offenders.

Operation Selsset was set up to tackle potential increase and anti-social behaviour during summer school leave times. This has been a successful operation with few incidents received.

### Upcoming:-

The next community forum meeting will be held on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> September 6.30-8.30pm. This will be held at the Village Hall, Sitwell Street.

The next Police surgery will be held Monday 6th October 5pm-7pm. This will



be held at The Library, Sitwell Street.

[Notable arrests/detections:-](#)

During August a number of notable arrests have been made in Spondon.

4 males were arrested for theft from vehicle. 3 of these were arrested after a report was received of 3 males looking into vehicles in the early hours of the morning, the same night a vehicle was broken into and cash stolen from within. All 4 are on police bail pending further enquiries and forensic results.

A male is currently on police bail after being arrested for breaking into a house and stealing several items from within, including the hot water tank and television.
