

Spondon Clean Sweep

On Monday 13 February a refuse vehicle will be provided at the locations and times below for you to dispose of your unwanted household items, free of charge.

Monday 13th February 2012

7.30 – 10.30am Craddock Avenue (opposite Langley Road by bungalow's)

12.00 – 14.45pm Beresford Drive junction with Gravel Pit Lane

How to dispose of your items ...

- 1. Get your items ready for disposal.
- 2. Take them to one of the collection points between the times specified.
- 3. Hand your items to the collectors by the vehicle.
- 4. Collectors will load your items for safety reasons, do not attempt to load items onto the vehicles.



Please do not bring or leave your items for disposal at the stated locations outside of these times - the sites will continue to be monitored and anybody found fly-tipping may be subject to a maximum fine of £50,000.

We will accept the following items ...

- Soft furnishings (such as mattresses and cushions)
- Household furniture (such as chairs and tables)
- Bagged household waste
- Carpets
- Fridges/freezers/washing machines/microwaves
- Televisions/videos
- Bagged garden cuttings.

All items must not be more than 4 feet (1.22 Metres) in diameter

We will not accept the following items ...

- Motor vehicle parts
- Any fluids (such as paint, creosote, varnish, fuel and oil)
- Gas bottles
- Builders waste (such as concrete, bricks, sand and rubble)
- Soil
- Asbestos
- Batteries
